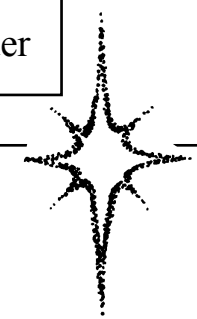

Kevin Nieman (A. Mus.) – Choral Director

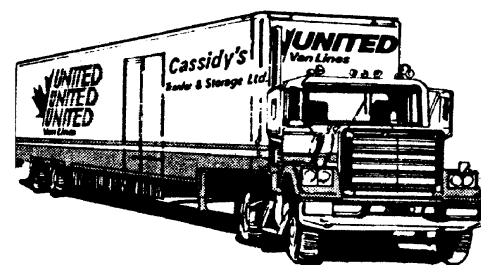
