She currently teaches music at General Panet High School, and directs the school's concert band and vocal group.



Miniwanka is an imitative piece describing the various states of water. The text consists of words for water, rain, stream, river, fog and ocean in the following North American Indian languages: Dakota, Wappo, Crow, Chinook, Achumawi, Otchipwe, Salish, Natick, Klamath and Luiseno. The piece chronicles the transformation of water from raindrops, to streams and waterfalls, to guiet lakes, to broad rivers and finally through estuaries to the ocean.

Needless to say, the choir has had its challenges in bringing this unique piece of music to you. There is little traditional musical notation - the effect is achieved through vocal representations of the design elements of the score. The following is a piece of the score:
