

He is currently music director at the Church of the Most Holy Name of Jesus.

Darlene TerMarsch – Accompanist

A native of the Ottawa Valley, Darlene TerMarsch is accomplished in piano, vocal, organ, harpsichord and percussion, and has studied piano and voice through the Royal Conservatory of Music.
