Caryl A. Clark, Choral Director (B. Music, B. Education)

Caryl Clark, our Director since March 1981, was born in Toronto, where she studied both violin and piano as a child. At the University of Toronto she specialized in Music Education, and majored on the violin. After several years of teaching in Toronto secondary schools, she moved to Pembroke, and joined the Pembroke Community Choir as Director, the Deep River Symphony Orchestra where she is presently Concertmaster, and began a now-thriving practice of private violin teaching.



Cheryl Palmai-Soprano

Cheryl received her music training in Toronto where she taught voice and piano for several years before moving to Deep River. She was with the D.R. Choral Group and D.R. Symphony Orchestra and sang Bach, Brahms, Haydn, Puccini, and Vaughan-Williams. In 1981 she appeared with the Nepean Symphony Orchestra singing opera excerpts and thirty concerts of 'Peter and The Wolf' for school concerts. Upon moving to Ottawa in 1982 she joined the Orpheus Society for her first stage production, playing Nettie in 'Carousel'. She is now teaching music in Ottawa.

Susan Dent-Soprano

Susan Dent studied voice at the Royal Conservatory of Music-Toronto. Active musically since the age of 10 she has regularly performed with church choirs as chorister, soloist or director and, concurrent with this, has taken roles with various musical societies and theatrical groups. She has also studied flute and piano. Among the Chamber Choirs with which Susan has sung are the Jubilate Singers (Toronto) and the Pro Arte Society (Kingston). Currently she is a member of the Cantandos (Deep River).

Helen Dixon-Contralto

Mrs Helen Dixon sang for twelve years, five as soloist, with the choir of All Saint Anglican Church (Westboro), Ottawa, William Gush, Director. She now sings with the Eganville Community Choir, Mervin Fick, Director, and with the Pembroke Community Choir.
