

LAURIE ROSEWARNE

(FREE-BASS ACCORDION)

Ottawa-based accordionist Laurie Rosewarne studied at Carleton University (B.A. Music) and at The Royal Conversatory of Music in Toronto (A.R.C.T. in accordion), where she studied with Joseph Macerollo. She has participated in many competitions, among them the 1983 Trofeo Mundial in Venezuela.

At present she is editor of the newsletter of the Classical Accordion Society of Canada and is a member of the Alliance for Canadian New Music Projects.

She is also active as an accompanist and is co-founder of Camerata Music where she teaches accordion, piano and theory.

THE PEMBROKE COMMUNITY CHOIR is in its 29th year. Rehearsals are held every Monday evening in Zion Lutheran Church Hall at 7:30 p.m. for their two main concerts in Spring and Advent, as well as for other occasions. They will sing in a performance of Mozart's Requiem and Haydn's Lord Nelson Mass, at the St. Denis Centre, Windsor. On May 16th we get together for our annual Choir Banquet and year-end festivities.
