Jessica was involved with the former Ottawa Valley Music Festival under Mervin Fick and later Peter Morris, since its inception in 1994 and has performed as soprano soloist with them many times over the years, and had a blast delving back into her love of Musical Theatre with Streetlight Theatre's recent production of "Newsies."
